KIS Curriculum Description – American Curriculum

At Knowledge International School, the Educational Program is designed to meet our Mission and Vision. Our program is not only academic, but focuses on students as individuals, and includes parent involvement at all levels. It also reflects the UAE national identity, integrates real-life connections and international mindedness.

The school is guided by the California State Learning Standards and Next Generation Science Standards and follows the Ministry Programs for Arabic Language, Arabic Social Studies, Moral Education, and Islamic Studies (for both Arab and Non-Arab learners). To ensure a quality education, the instructional process—including how the curriculum is devised and delivered, is constantly monitored, and updated. Experienced highly qualified teaching staff, ongoing professional development, use of relevant technologies, and the monitoring and observation of teaching staff is vital to ensure successful teaching and learning.

Formative and summative assessments are used to guide the instructional process.

External assessments are used to validate the performance of students in comparison to national and/or international norms.



Inclusion Department:

At KIS, we prioritize and strive to ensure that Inclusion is at the heart of our practices benefiting our entire school community. We are strongly committed to set high expectations and ambitions for all our children and expect them to participate in every part of school life - with a key focus on their wellbeing and progress.

KIS aims to support children by removing barriers to their inclusion, whether for individuals or groups of children, and respond to a spectrum of diverse needs by setting suitable challenges that are best placed to bring out the full potential from our children.

Furthermore, at KIS, we ensure an effective program is in place to identify students who are gifted and talented and make certain they are provided with an abundance of opportunities to further hone and develop their gifts and talents.

As outlined by the United Arab Emirates School Inspection Framework (2015-2016):

Gifted - The term giftedness refers to “a student who is in possession of untrained and spontaneously-expressed exceptional natural ability in one or more domains of human ability”. These domains will include intellectual, creative, social, physical abilities. In the case of a gifted student, whilst exceptional potential will be present, they may underachieve.

Talented – The term talented refers to “a student who has been able to transform their ‘giftedness’ into exceptional performance”. Talented students will always demonstrate exceptional levels of competence in the specific domains of human ability.



School Policy & Rules

School Operating Hours

- School gates open at 6:45AM and close at 7:45 AM
- The Morning Assembly starts at 7:30 am
- Advisory sessions for grades 1 to 6 start at 7:45AM – 8:00 AM, while for KGs start at 7:30 AM
- PreKG to Grade 6 dismissal time is at 14:00 PM. On Fridays at 11:30AM. Buses for PreKG to Grade 6 leave at 13:50 PM\ On Fridays at 11:20 AM

Attendance and Tardiness

- Students should be in school no later than 7:30 am
- Late arrivals, after 8:00, will be admitted through gate 2 and their lateness shall be recorded. If it's more than 3 times, the parent will be called for a meeting.
- In case of absence, students must provide a valid doctor's note or a legitimate reason for their absence. It should not exceed the limit of absences.

Books, Bags and school devices

- all books to be kept in school unless the student has homework or a quiz. All books to be sent home every Friday.
- It's of utmost importance to consider the weight of your child's bag to be safe to carry

Lunch Boxes

- Child shall be provided with enough and healthy food and snacks.
- Kindly pack healthy lunches with a variety of fruits and vegetables
- Fast food, chocolates, chips, sodas, energy drinks, gums, gummy bears and sugary products are strictly prohibited. Such will be confiscated in case they are found with the students.



School Policy & Rules

Uniform

- Students must comply with the correct school uniform. (Full uniform set). Failure to do so, the parents shall be called for a meeting.
- PE Uniform must be worn to school whenever students have PE lessons as indicated on the timetable.
- Only White, Black or Navy-Blue shoes are permitted.
- You are kindly advised to pack an extra set of clothing for your KG child
- Cleanliness and Hygiene
- Long nails, untidy hair, jewelry, or accessories are strictly prohibited. Long hair for boys is not allowed. Colored hair for girls is not allowed.
- Students must always maintain a clean and neat appearance.
- Personal hygiene products must be considered for older students.
- Mobile phones are strictly prohibited. If found, it will be kept in school till further notice.

Buses

- During fog and bad weather conditions, buses will come to a complete stop and will not resume until the weather clears
- In case of any misbehaving, the student shall be removed from the bus with no fees refund.
